

ADMISSION REGULATIONS

of the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education «Izhevsk State Medical Academy» of the Ministry of Healthcare of The Russian Federation

Foreign citizens and stateless people admission considerations

118. Foreign citizens and stateless people have a right to pursue higher education using budgetary allocations under the international agreements of the Russian Federation, Federal Acts or education quota of foreign citizens and stateless people (hereafter referred to as education quota for foreign citizens) specified by the government of Russia, as well as at the expense of natural and legal persons under the for-profit education service agreements.

119. The student is accepted for studies within the education quota for foreign citizens under the policies of federal executive agency that implements policymaking and legal and regulatory framework in education. The student is accepted for studies within the education quota for foreign citizens by a separate order (orders) of ISMA.

120. Foreign and stateless compatriots living abroad have a right to pursue higher education on equal terms with Russian citizens subject to requirements specified by Article 17 of the Federal Act No. 99 of 24 May 1999 "On State policy respecting Russian citizens abroad" (hereafter referred to as Federal Act No. 99).

121. Specialist program training admission exclusive rights provided under the Federal Act No. 273 do not apply to compatriots living abroad without Russian citizenship unless otherwise provided by the international agreement of the Russian federation.

122. ISMA specifies at least two general education entrance examinations for specialist courses admission of foreign citizens and stateless people under the for-profit education service agreements. Examinations are chosen by ISMA at its own discretion from a list of entrance examinations determined by the Order No. 1204 for a respective specialty or major. ISMA independently determines the required number of students and holds a separate selection of foreign citizens and stateless people for admission if the list of entrance examinations for foreign citizens and stateless people specified by ISMA varies from the list of entrance examinations for other individuals. Entrance examinations and admission of foreign students on a contract basis end on 1 October 2020. The following list of examinations is specified if the entrance examinations are conducted in Russian (section 73 of the Regulations): General Medicine (Chemistry, Russian); Pediatrics (Chemistry, Russian); Dentistry (Chemistry, Russian). The following list of examinations is specified if the entrance examinations are conducted in English: General Medicine (Chemistry, English); Pediatrics (Chemistry, English); Dentistry (Chemistry, English).

123. When submitting the documents for admission in their in application for admission foreign citizens and stateless people specify particulars of the identification document or a foreign citizen identification document valid in the Russian Federation or a stateless person identification document valid in the Russian Federation under the Article 10 of the Federal Act No. 115 of 25 July 2002 On the legal situation of foreign citizens (hereafter referred to as foreign citizen identification document) and presents an identification and citizenship document or a foreign citizen identification document in original or in a copy under the item 1 of Section 59 of the Regulations.

When applying for admission to ISMA foreign citizen additionally presents the following list of documents:

- copy of an identification document of the applicant or a foreign citizen identification document valid in the Russian Federation (with visa or valid registration certificate if the applicant is currently in the Russian Federation);

- national educational certificate or its certified copy; alternatively, foreign educational and/or qualification certificate recognized in the Russian Federation as equivalent to the national educational certificate or its certified copy as well as a copy of the approval certificate of the educational certificate where statutorily provided by the Russian Federation;

- certified Russian translation of a foreign educational certificate and its supplements if they are statutorily required in the state in which the document was issued;

- Russian Federation entry visa copy if the applicant came to Russian Federation on an entry visa;

- 2 3x4cm photographs (no headgear, with stamp corners on the bottom right);

- copy of a birth certificate;

- copy of a migration card;

- certificate of the foreign documents equivalence by the Federal Education and Science Supervision Service;

- State Test of Russian as a Foreign Language pass certification;

- confirmation of the absence of contraindications for pursuing a respective degree in the Russian Federation with a special note with HIV test results.

After the documents are verified by the International department the applicant receives an approval certificate and a certificate confirming that the applicant is briefed.

124. Under the Article 17 of the Federal Act No. 99 compatriot applicant submits documents provided by the Article 17 of the Federal Act No. 99 in original or in copy along with documents specified in the Section 59 of the Regulations.

124.1. Foreign citizens applying for admission by virtue of international agreements submit documents confirming their status as the signatories to their respective agreements along with documents specified in the Section 59 of the Regulations.

125. Admission of foreign citizens and stateless people for courses containing highly classified information can only be implemented within the education quota for foreign citizens in compliance with highly classified information legislation of Russian Federation.
